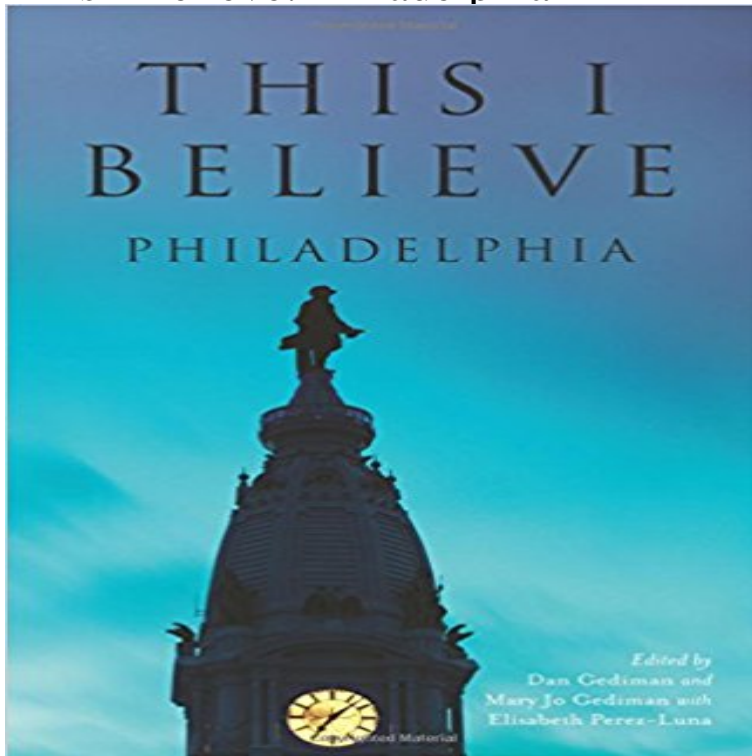


This I Believe: Philadelphia
