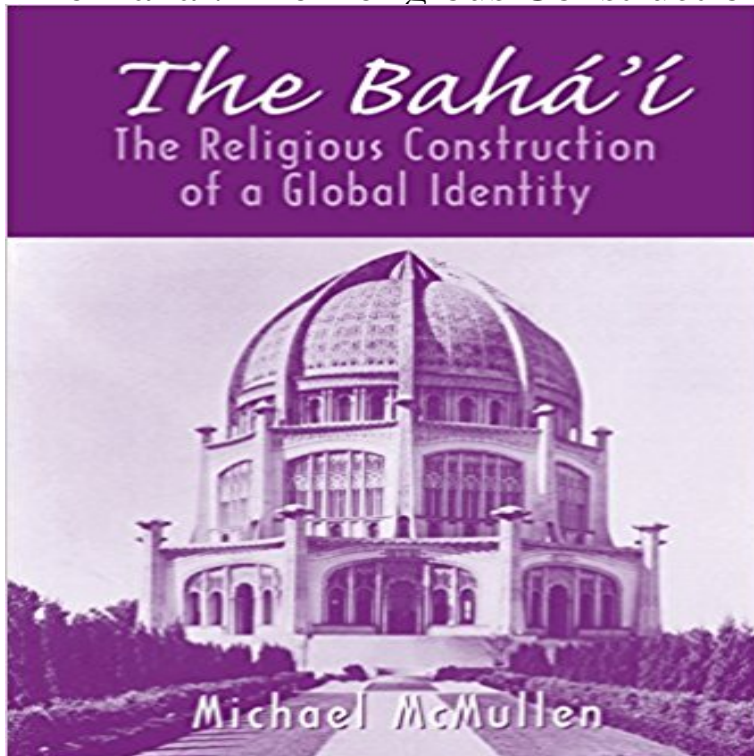


The Bahai: The Religious Construction of a Global Identity



The Bahai Faith is one of the fastest growing, but least studied, of the worlds religions. Adherents view themselves as united by a universal belief that transcends national boundaries. Michael McMullen examines how the Bahai develop and maintain this global identity. Taking the Bahai community in Atlanta, Georgia, as a case in point, his book is the first to comprehensively examine the tenets of this little-understood faith. McMullen notes that, to the Bahai, Buddha, Moses, Jesus, and Mohammed are all divinely sent teachers of the Truth, whose messages conform to the needs of their individual cultures and historical periods. But religion which draws from the teaching of Bahá'ulláh, a nineteenth-century Persian encourages its members to think of themselves as global citizens. It also seeks to establish unity among its members through adherence to a Bahai worldview. By examining the Atlanta Bahai community, McMullen shows how this global identity is interpreted locally. He discusses such topics as: the organizational structure and authority relations in the Bahai Administrative Order; Bahai evangelicalism; and the social boundaries between Bahais and the wider culture.
