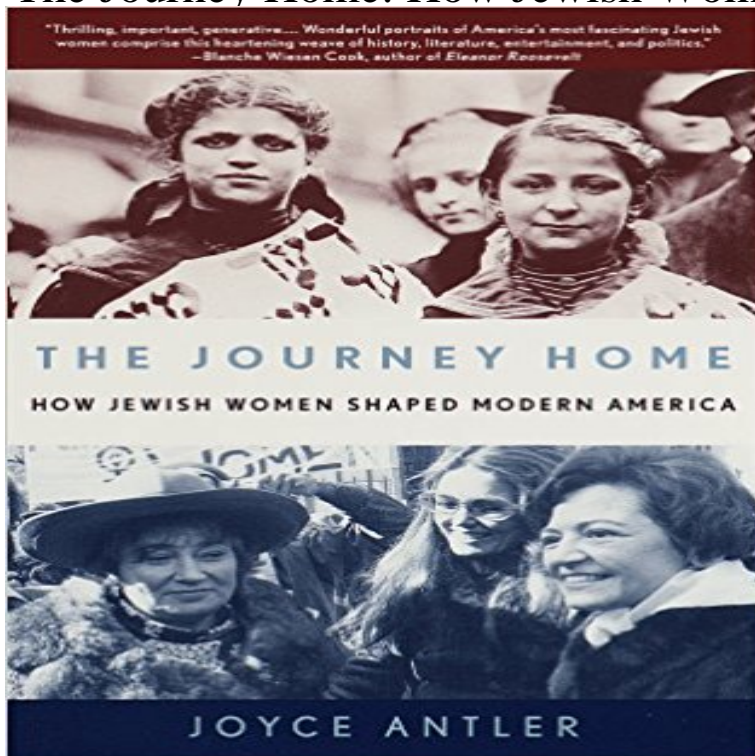


The Journey Home: How Jewish Women Shaped Modern America
