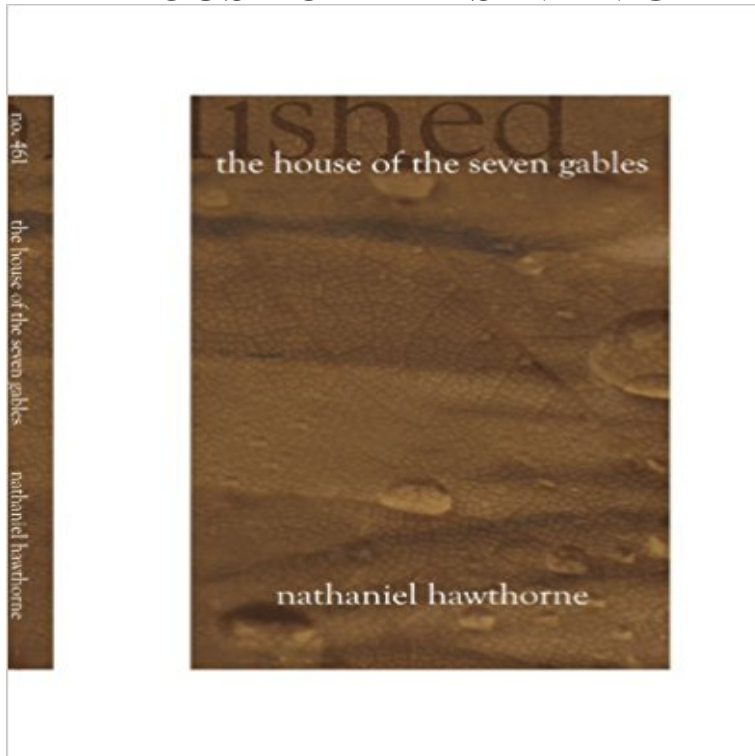


## THE HOUSE OF THE SEVEN GABLES
