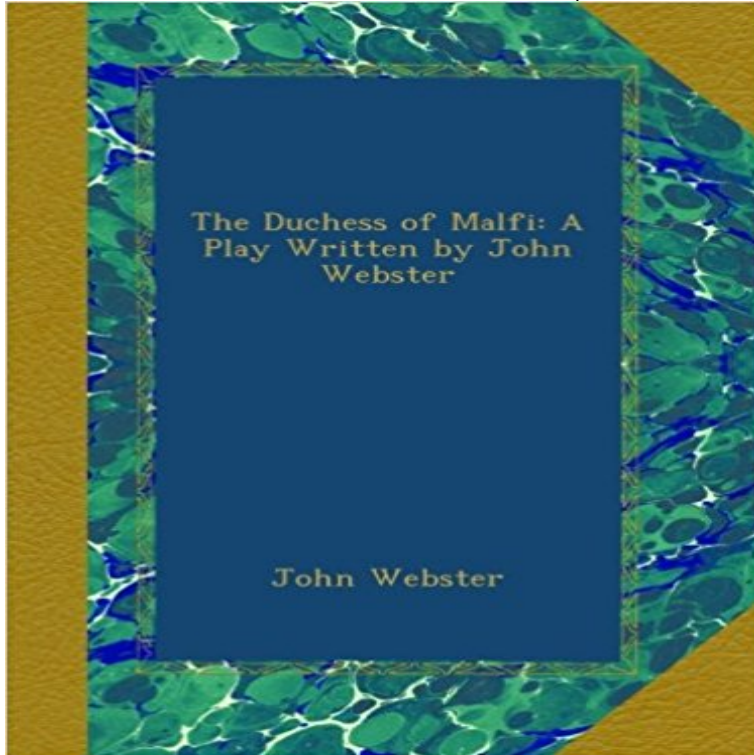


The Duchess of Malfi: A Play Written by John Webster
